## Gospel Reflection for the Fourteenth Sunday of Ordinary Time: God's Campaign Trail!



How can we promote Jesus' message in a society that tries to confine Christianity to a Sunday afternoon TV Slot? How do we promote Jesus' teachings of unity and sharing in a world of division and materialism? How do we campaign for peace and love in a world hampered by indifference and injustice?

We might feel small in face of impacting our beliefs on an unbelieving world. That we feel small perhaps helps us to

understand the task the early disciples faced in Luke's Gospel. The scene set in to-day's gospel must have looked something like a biblical 'campaign trail'. Jesus sent seventy-two disciples ahead of him in pairs to every town and place he intended to visit to prepare the way. Jesus knew that they were up against the odds. He describes them as lambs among wolves. "The harvest is abundant," he says, "but the labourers are few." More credit then, to those early disciples that the Christian message has survived for over two thousand years. What can we learn from their obvious success?

Jesus gave his early disciples some important practical advice. His first words of advice were for us to travel light. How can we concentrate on impacting Jesus' will if we are burdened with other concerns? Having a clear and focussed mind is crucial to any kind of success. Next Jesus advocates relying on hospitality and walking away from opposition. Perhaps today we would call it 'knowing one's audience'. In a nutshell, Jesus is asking us to focus on the job in hand, avoid distraction, and not to be deterred by opposition or setbacks.

## Ciste agus Subh: Parish Partnership Cake & Jam Sale In aid of the Ishiara Sand Dam Project This weekend, Sunday 7th July, a Cake & Jam Sale will be held in

the Parish Hall after both the 10.00a.m and 12 Noon Mass. The Sand Dam Project is part of our Parish

Partnership with Ishiara, Kenya. At the moment, 90% of people in Ishiara have no running water. The best way of providing water in a sustainable way is by means of sand dams. They are relatively low cost constructions that are then managed and maintained



by the local community.

These dams will provide drinking water, the means to grow crops,



cause a reduction in the number of mosquitoes (thereby curtailing water-borne diseases), and will allow the growth of crops and vege-

Total cost of project: €25,000. Amount raised to date: €10,000.

#### **GDPR** and Parish Records

What is GDPR? The General Data Protection Regulation is European legislation governing personal data which came into effect on 25th May 2018.

The following are among the changes being implemented in the parish:

- As a result of GDPR, no personal data held in parish records will be visible or accessible to the general
- All requests for issuing of certificates (eg: Baptismal records, etc.), must be on an official application form and accompanied by photo I.D.
- Only Office Staff will have access to parish computers. All are now password controlled.
- Office doors will be closed to the public outside of normal office opening hours.
