Buried Treasure



"The Kingdom of Heaven is like a treasure buried in a field; which a person finds and hides again, and out of joy goes and sells all that he has and buys that field."

"The Kingdom of Heaven is like a merchant searching for fine pearls. When he finds a pearl of great price, he goes and sells all

he has and buys it." In both parables both men appreciate the true value of what they have discovered. Both men are certain about the wisdom of what they must do and are willing to put everything on the line to secure their newfound treasure.

Today Jesus is asking us to determine how much we treasure the Kingdom of Heaven. How valuable is Heaven to us and what are we prepared to do to secure it? Are we prepared to give all we've got and to renounce everything that gets in the way? If the two men in the parables had passed their treasure by or failed to recognise the treasure's value, we would have thought them insane, yet this is how we behave all the time.

All too often we are prepared to let the Kingdom of Heaven slip through our fingers. Perhaps we do this because we have never stopped to reflect on how valuable the Kingdom of Heaven is. Perhaps we have recognised the value of God's Kingdom to us but have forgotten it in the day-to-day distractions of putting meals on the table and paying the bills. Perhaps heaven's rewards seem so distant that we prefer instead to work for more immediate and tangible rewards, home improvements, fame, social acceptance and career development. Perhaps we think we can work on God's agenda and our own agenda simultaneously, recognising the value of God's Kingdom but not quite able to renounce our own self-interest.

Jesus gives us some concrete advice. He tells us that those who study the scriptures and search diligently will find the discernment to recognise God's treasure and the wisdom to secure it.

Confirmation and First Holy Communion Ceremonies 2020

It has been a long wait for the boys and girls who are preparing for their First Holy Communion and Confirmation. We now look forward to the rescheduled Ceremonies as outlined below. Given the requirements for social distancing and the large numbers of students receiving Holy Communion for the first time, it will only be possible for the child, his/her parents and one other family member to attend the ceremony.

For the Confirmation ceremony, the child, his/her parents and the sponsor will only be able to attend. The liturgies will be simplified with teachers reading the prayers of the faithful and the Mass readings. Choirs and congregational singing is not recommended at this time but there will be a cantor and musician at each ceremony. There will be no offertory procession or procession with symbols so as to minimise the possibility of contagion.

These arrangements for First Holy Communion and Confirmation are in place as long as the current Government Road Map for reopening society continues. If there is a resurgence in cases and further lockdowns, these plans will need to be revised accordingly. It is also recommended that all attending these ceremonies wear a face mask
