## PARISH MEETING REPORT

A report on parish meetings which were held to discuss Bishop Phonsie's letter will be published shortly. You will be invited to suggest amendments or additions to the report and an agreed report with recommendations of the parish will be forwarded to Bishop's House. The Parish Leadership Team is currently analysing the main themes which emerged from the data recorded at the meetings. There was almost universal agreement that churches should not be closed. People felt that the current Mass schedule in our parish is not sustainable in the long term. Whilst we have enough priests at present to serve our parish, we are not in a position to assist other parishes if priests were sick or on holidays. People were not happy with Mass times. In particular they felt that the children's Mass was too early and that the Saturday Mass in St Mary's was too late. There was also a call to establish a team to conduct lay led liturgies in the absence of a priest. That team would have to be trained properly.

Other themes which are emerging from our analysis include the need to reach out to engage with youth in the parish and to build up lay involvement in ministry in the parish. A full report will be published, and we would welcome your feedback before drafting our submission to Bishop's House.
